## PLANT DISEASES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 9) 1996

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Plant Diseases Amendment Regulations (No. 9) 1996*.

**Schedule 1 amended**

2. Schedule 1 to the *Plant Diseases Regulations 1989\** is amended —

(a) in Part A by deleting the item relating to Lupin and substituting the following item —

“ Lupin . . .                    1                    1                    16,52                    —                    ”;

and

(b) in Part B —

(i) in item 1 by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical position the following —

“  
Lupin: Plants — Anthracnose (*Colletotrichum gloeosporioides*) and Fusarium Wilt (*Fusarium oxysporum f. lupini*).  
”;

and

(ii) by deleting item 51 and substituting the following item —

“  
51. Lupin seed — Anthracnose and Fusarium Wilt  
Entry of Lupin seed is permitted if the seed is —  
(a) approved for entry;  
(b) to be grown in post-entry quarantine;  
(c) to be screened for disease; and  
(d) to be found free from lupin attacking strains of the fungus Anthracnose (*Colletotrichum gloeosporioides*) and Fusarium Wilt (*Fusarium oxysporum f. lupini*) before the release of progeny.  
”
