POLICE ACT 1892

POLICE FORCE AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (No. 2) 1996

Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 9 with the approval of the Minister for Police.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Police Force Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1996*.

Principal regulations

2. In these regulations the *Police Force Regulations 1979** are referred to as the principal regulations.

Regulation 502 amended

3. (1) Regulation 502 (1) of the principal regulations is amended —

(a) in paragraph (a), by deleting “a British subject;” and substituting the following —

“
an Australian citizen, or a permanent resident, within the meaning of the *Australian Citizenship Act 1948* of the Commonwealth;
”;

(b) in paragraph (e) (i), by deleting “and not more than 33 years of age”;

(c) in paragraph (g), by inserting after “as a member” the following —

“ , and if required to do so by the Commissioner, ”; and

(d) in paragraph (h), by inserting after “to do so” the following —

“ by the Commissioner ”.

(2) Regulation 502 (2) of the principal regulations is repealed and the following subregulation is substituted —

“
(2) The activities to be undertaken by an applicant for appointment as a member, for the purposes of a physical performance evaluation required under subregulation (1) (g), shall be as determined by the Commissioner.
”.

(3) Regulation 502 (5) of the principal regulations is repealed.
