INTERPRETATION ACT 1984****BARRISTERS' BOARD AMENDMENT RULES (No. 3) 1991**

Made by the Barristers' Board under section 6 of the *Legal Practitioners Act 1893* and section 25 of the *Interpretation Act 1984*.

**Citation**

1. These rules may be cited as the *Barristers' Board Amendment Rules (No. 3) 1991*.

**Commencement**

2. These rules shall come into operation on the day on which the *Legal Practitioners Amendment Act 1990* comes into operation.

**Rule 21 amended**

3. Rule 21 of the *Barristers' Board Rules 1949\** is amended—

(a) by inserting after subrule (1) the following subrule—

“ (1a) For the purposes of section 9 (c) of the Act the fee of \$100 is prescribed. ”; and

(b) in subrule (2) by deleting “sum of \$25.20” and substituting the following—

“ fee specified in subrule (1a) ”.
