

TOBACCO CONTROL ACT 1990

TOBACCO CONTROL (STATEMENT ON VENDING MACHINES)
REGULATIONS 1991

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Tobacco Control (Statement on Vending Machines) Regulations 1991*.

Commencement

2. These regulations shall come into operation on 9 August 1991.

Statement on vending machines

3. (1) The statement referred to in section 11 (2) (b) of the Act shall be in the form of 2 notices —

(a) one of which shall consist of a health warning and one of which shall state —

“IT IS AN OFFENCE TO SELL OR SUPPLY CIGARETTES AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS TO ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS. PENALTY UP TO \$20 000.”; and

(b) each of which shall be displayed in a sign occupying a total area of not less than 210 mm in height and 300 mm in width, and shall be written in letters which —

(i) appear in Helvetica Bold Capitals;

(ii) are reproduced in white on a black background; and

(iii) are not less than 15 mm in height.

(2) In subregulation (1), “health warning” means one of the following warnings —

(a) “SMOKING CAUSES LUNG CANCER

Health Authority Warning”;

(b) “SMOKING CAUSES HEART DISEASE

Health Authority Warning”;

(c) “SMOKING DAMAGES YOUR LUNGS

Health Authority Warning”; or

(d) “SMOKING REDUCES YOUR FITNESS

Health Authority Warning”.
