## **Products Symbol Regulations 1980**

### **1. Citation**

These regulations may be cited as the *Products Symbol Regulations 1980*<sup>1</sup>.

### **2. Interpretation**

In these regulations unless the contrary intention appears —  
*the Act* means the *Western Australian Products Symbol Act 1972*.

### **3. Certificate of appointment**

- (1) Every person appointed to be an inspector under section 7 of the Act shall be furnished with a certificate evidencing his appointment, in the form of Form 1 in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) The certificate referred to in subregulation (1) shall carry a photograph of the appointee and be signed by the appointee and the Minister.

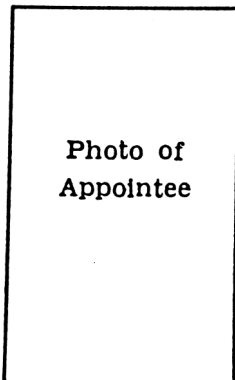
