Criminal Procedure Amendment Rules 2018

Made by the judges of the Supreme Court.

1. Citation

These rules are the *Criminal Procedure Amendment Rules 2018*.

2. Commencement

These rules come into operation as follows —

- (a) rules 1 and 2 — on the day on which these rules are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the rules — on the day after that day.

3. Rules amended

These rules amend the *Criminal Procedure Rules 2005*.

4. Rule 50 amended

Delete rule 50(2) and insert:

- (2) A registrar may release an exhibit to a person if —
 - (a) the release is in accordance with section 170 of the Act; and
 - (b) the person is —
 - (i) the party who tendered the exhibit; or
 - (ii) a person who the registrar considers is entitled to the exhibit.
- (3) A court may direct that an exhibit not be released to a person.
