### **Biosecurity and Agriculture Management (Identification and Movement of Stock and Apiaries) Amendment Regulations 2022**

SL 2022/17

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management (Identification and Movement of Stock and Apiaries) Amendment Regulations 2022*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on 1 April 2022.

**3. Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management (Identification and Movement of Stock and Apiaries) Regulations 2013*.

**4. Regulation 3 amended**

In regulation 3 insert in alphabetical order:

*poultry* means a bird of a species (including a hybrid of a species) that is set out in the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Regulations 2013* Schedule 1 item 11 column 3;

**5. Regulation 4 amended**

In regulation 4 —

(a) after paragraph (e) insert:

(ea) an emu;

(b) after paragraph (i) insert:

(ia) poultry;

**6. Regulation 7 amended**

Delete regulation 7(2) and insert:

(2) Subregulation (1) does not apply to a person who owns or purchases emus, ostriches or poultry if —

(a) the person owns —

(i) fewer than 50 poultry; and

(ii) fewer than 10 emus and ostriches (in any combination);

and

(b) the person is not an owner or purchaser of any other species of stock.

**7. Part 7 Division 3 deleted**

Delete Part 7 Division 3.

**8. Regulation 188 amended**

In regulation 188(b) delete “ostrich; or” and insert:

emu or ostrich, or poultry; or
