## **Workers' Compensation and Injury Management Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2023**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

### **1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Workers' Compensation and Injury Management Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2023*.

### **2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published on the WA legislation website;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

### **3. Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Workers' Compensation and Injury Management Regulations 1982*.

### **4. Regulation 68 amended**

- (1) In regulation 68(1) delete the definition of *firefighting employment*.
- (2) In regulation 68(1) insert in alphabetical order:

*communications systems officer* means a person —

- (a) employed by the department of the Public Service principally assisting in the

administration of the *Fire and Emergency Services Act 1998*; and

- (b) whose primary duties in that employment include to receive telephone calls and dispatch emergency services in response to incidents;

***incident*** has the meaning given in the *Fire and Emergency Services Act 1998* section 3;

- (3) Delete regulation 68(3)(d) and insert:

- (d) employment by or under the Crown in right of the State —
  - (i) to which an industrial award or industrial agreement relating to firefighting applies; and
  - (ii) that is in a firefighter classification under the award or agreement;
- (e) employment as a communications systems officer.

- (4) In regulation 68(4)(c) delete “firefighting employment —” and insert:

employment prescribed in subregulation (3)(d) or (e) —
