#### 13C. Prescribing practitioner

(1) In this regulation —

endorsed midwife means a person registered under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (Western Australia) in the midwifery profession whose registration is endorsed under section 94 of that Law.

- (2) For the purposes of paragraph (b) of the definition of *prescribing practitioner* in section 202MD(1) of the Act, the following classes of registered health practitioners are prescribed
  - (a) endorsed midwife;
  - (b) nurse practitioner.
