Local Government (Elections) Amendment Regulations 2024

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Local Government (Elections) Amendment Regulations 2024*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published on the WA legislation website;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on 1 July 2024.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997*.

4. Regulation 3 amended

In regulation 3 in the definition of *silent elector* delete paragraph (a) and insert:

- (a) who is a silent elector as defined in the *Electoral Act 1907* section 4(1); or

5. Regulation 12A amended

Delete regulation 12A(3)(b)(i) and insert:

- (i) that the claimant is a silent elector under the *Electoral Act 1907*;

6. Regulation 13 amended

Delete regulation 13(1A)(b)(i) and insert:

- (i) that the person is a silent elector under the *Electoral Act 1907*;

7. Regulation 20 amended

Delete regulation 20(2) and insert:

- (2) Subregulation (1)(c) and (d) do not apply to silent electors.

8. Regulation 46 amended

Delete regulation 46(4)(b) and insert:

- (b) the register of electors, a roll or another document prepared under the *Electoral Act 1907*; and

9. Regulation 62 amended

In regulation 62(3)(b) delete “an electoral roll or other” and insert:

the register of electors, a roll or another

10. Schedule 1 Form 16 amended

In Schedule 1 Form 16 delete “an electoral roll or other” and insert:

the register of electors, a roll or another
