Declared Places (Mental Impairment) Regulations 2015

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Declared Places (Mental Impairment) Regulations 2015*.

[Regulation 1 amended: SL 2024/179 r. 4.]

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day on which the *Mental Health Act 2014* section 350 comes into operation.

3. Prescribed advocates

- (1) A mental health advocate as defined in the *Mental Health Act 2014* section 4 is prescribed for the purposes of the definition of ***advocate*** in section 51 of the Act.
- (2) The Chief Mental Health Advocate as defined in the *Mental Health Act 2014* section 4 is prescribed for the purposes of the definition of ***chief advocate*** in section 51 of the Act.
