No. 27 of 2003

An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund —

- a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2000 under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1999*;
- a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2001 under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 2000*; and
- a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2002 under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 2001*.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

s. 1

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 4) 2003*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. Appropriation for capital purposes

- (1) The sum of \$88 240 000.00 being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1999* and charged to the Consolidated Fund under that Act, is appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1.
- (2) The sum of \$119 634 748.10 being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 2000* and charged to the Consolidated Fund under that Act, is appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 2.
- (3) The sum of \$39 012 000.00 being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 2001* and charged to the Consolidated Fund under that Act, is appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 3.
