**An Act to amend the *Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899* and the  
*Electoral Act 1907*.**

[Assented to 23 May 2005]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**1. Short title**

This is the *Constitution and Electoral Amendment Act 2005*.

**2. Commencement**

- (1) Subject to subsection (2), this Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- (2) If the *Electoral Amendment and Repeal Act 2005* has not received the Royal Assent before the day referred to in subsection (1), this Act comes into operation immediately after that Act comes into operation.

**3. Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899 amended**
