(CONSOLIDATED FUND) ACT
(No. 3) 1999**

No. 12 of 1999

AN ACT to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund a sum for recurrent payments made during the year ended 30 June 1997 under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1996*.

[Assented to 19 May 1999]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 3) 1999*.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Appropriation of purpose

3. The sum of \$199,588,450.05 being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 1996* and charged to the Consolidated Fund under that Act, is appropriated for the recurrent services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1.
