**APPROPRIATION
(CONSOLIDATED FUND) ACT
(No. 1) 1998**

No. 36 of 1998

AN ACT to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Fund certain sums for the services and purposes of the year ending 30 June 1999.

[Assented to 3 July 1998.]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 1) 1998*.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Issue and application of moneys

3. (1) The sum of \$5 680 434 000 shall be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Fund as supply granted to Her Majesty for the year from 1 July 1998 to 30 June 1999.

(2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Bill (No. 2) 1998*.

Appropriation of Purpose

4. The sum of \$5 680 434 000 granted by section 3 as supply to Her Majesty is appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the recurrent services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
