# **Curtin University of Technology Amendment Act 1998**

**No. 43 of 1998**

**An Act to amend the *Curtin University of Technology Act 1966*.**

[Assented to 5 November 1998]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Curtin University of Technology Amendment Act 1998*.

**2. Commencement**

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

**3. The Act amended**

The amendments in this Act are to the *Curtin University of Technology Act 1966\**.

**4. Section 7 amended**

After section 7(2) the following subsection is inserted —

“

- (3) The University may carry out its functions and exercise its powers, including the power to enter into business arrangements, within or outside the State.

”

**5. Section 21A amended**

Section 21A(1) is amended by deleting “in the State”.

**6. Section 34 amended**

Section 34(1) is amended by inserting after paragraph (m) the following paragraphs —

“

- (ma) the affiliation to or in connection with the University of any educational establishment, with the consent of the governing body of the educational establishment;

- (mb) the establishment and conduct of external teaching and educational facilities within or outside the State;

”
