**SUPREME COURT AMENDMENT  
ACT 1998**

**No. 31 of 1998**

**AN ACT to amend the *Supreme Court Act 1935*.**

[Assented to 3 July 1998.]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**Short title**

**1.** This Act may be cited as the *Supreme Court Amendment Act 1998*.

**Commencement**

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

**Section 167 amended**

3. Section 167 (1) of the *Supreme Court Act 1935*\* is amended by inserting after paragraph (d) the following paragraph —

“

(da) For prescribing or regulating any matters relating to the costs of proceedings, where those costs are not the subject of a determination under section 58W of the *Legal Practitioners Act 1893*.

”.
