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**APPROPRIATION  
(CONSOLIDATED FUND) ACT  
(No. 2) 1994**

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**No. 101 of 1994**

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**AN ACT to grant further supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Fund certain sums for the services and purposes of the year ending 30 June 1995.**

*[Assented to 29 December 1994.]*

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**Short title**

**1.** This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 2) 1994*.

**Commencement**

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

**Issue and application of moneys**

3. (1) The sum of \$221 155 000 shall be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Fund as supply granted to Her Majesty for the year from 1 July 1994 to 30 June 1995.

(2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Supply Act 1994*.

**Appropriation of Purpose**

4. The sum of \$421 155 000 comprising —

(a) the sum granted by section 3 as supply to Her Majesty; and

(b) \$200 000 000 of the sum granted by the *Supply Act 1994* as supply to Her Majesty,

is appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the capital services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Estimates for the year.
