**FAMILY COURT AMENDMENT
ACT 1991**

No. 24 of 1991

AN ACT to amend the *Family Court Act 1975*.

[Assented to 28 October 1991]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Family Court Amendment Act 1991*.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on such day as is fixed by proclamation.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, the *Family Court Act 1975** is referred to as the principal Act.
