

JUSTICES.

No. 67 of 1980.

AN ACT to amend section 167 of the Justices Act 1902-1979.

[Assented to 26 November 1980.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Justices Amendment Act 1980*.

(2) In this Act the Justices Act 1902-1979 is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Justices Act 1902-1980.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the twenty-eighth day after the day on which it is assented to by the Governor.
