AN ACT to amend the Audit Act 1904.

[Assented to 5 September 1984.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Audit Amendment Act 1984*. Short title.

(2) In this Act the Audit Act 1904 is referred to as the principal Act.

Ministerial
delegation.

“ 4A. The Treasurer may by writing delegate to another Minister of the Crown specified in the instrument of delegation all or any of his functions, powers and duties under this Act other than the power of delegation conferred by this section. ”.
