

INDUSTRY (ADVANCES).

No. 46 of 1982.

AN ACT to amend the Industry (Advances) Act
1947-1980.

[Assented to 26 August 1982.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Industry (Advances) Amendment Act 1982*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Industry (Advances) Act 1947-1980 is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted as approved 7 September 1981.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Industry (Advances) Act 1947-1982.

Section 3
amended.

2. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2) by deleting “in accordance with a direction given under this Act.” after paragraph (e) and inserting that passage in paragraph (e) after subparagraph (iii).

Section 7A
amended.

3. Section 7A of the principal Act is amended—

(a) in subsection (1)—

(i) by deleting “competition in the same field of activity in the State with” in subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (a) and substituting the following—

“ conflict with the interests in the same field of activity in the State of ” ; and

(ii) by deleting subparagraph (i) of paragraph (c) and substituting the following subparagraph—

“ (i) the proposal relates to the establishment of an industry not likely to be in conflict with the interests in the same field of activity in the State of existing businesses which have not benefited from Government assistance; ” ;

and

(b) in paragraph (b) of subsection (2), by deleting “a business was, at the time of approval of the application under this Act, likely to be in competition with” and substituting the following—

“ the establishment or development of an industry would, at the time of approval of the application under this Act, have been likely to be in conflict with the interests in the same field of activity in the State of ” .
