

## APPROPRIATION (GENERAL LOAN FUND).

No. 132 of 1976.

---

AN ACT to appropriate and apply from the General Loan Fund certain sums to make good the supplies granted for the service of the Year ending the 30th day of June, 1977, and to supplement grants made by the present Parliament during its Second Session in adjustment of the Vote "Advance to Treasurer, 1975-76" for charges during the Year ended the 30th day of June, 1976.

[Assented to 9th December, 1976.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act (General Loan Fund)*, 1976-77. Short title.

Application of moneys.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied, for or towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-seven the sum of Ninety-Six Million Two Hundred and Ninety-Nine Thousand Dollars from the General Loan Fund.

Appropriation of Supplies Schedules A and B.

3. (1) The sum of One Hundred and Forty-Six Million Two Hundred and Ninety-Nine Thousand Dollars granted by this Act, and the Acts mentioned in Schedule A to this Act, towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty, is appropriated from the General Loan Fund for the purposes and services expressed in Schedule B.

Advance to Treasurer Schedule C.

(2) The sum of Eight Million Two Hundred and Seventy-One Thousand and Three Hundred and Seventy-One Dollars and Sixty-Three Cents granted by this Act to supplement grants in confirmation of the expenditure from the Vote "Advance to Treasurer, 1975-76" for charges during the Year ended the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-six, is appropriated from the General Loan Fund and shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in Schedule C.
