

HOSPITALS.

No. 71 of 1976.

AN ACT to amend the Hospitals Act, 1927-1975.

[Assented to 6th October, 1976.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Hospitals Act Amendment Act, 1976*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Hospitals Act, 1927-1975 is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted as approved for reprint 11th December, 1972 and amended by Acts Nos. 10 of 1973 and 104 of 1975.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Hospitals Act, 1927-1976.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the interpretation "Advisory Council".

3. The principal Act is amended by repealing section 6A.

4. The Schedule to the principal Act is amended by deleting from the heading thereto the words "common to the Advisory Council and" and substituting the word "for".
