

OFFENDERS PROBATION AND PAROLE.

No. 39 of 1977.

AN ACT to amend section forty-two of the
Offenders Probation and Parole Act, 1963-1976.

[Assented to 7th November, 1977.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Offenders Probation and Parole Act Amendment Act, 1977.*

(2) In this Act the Offenders Probation and Parole Act, 1963-1976, is referred to as the principal Act.

2. Section 42 of the principal Act is amended by repealing subsection (3) and re-enacting it with amendments as follows—

(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of section forty-five of this Act, whenever a prisoner is released from prison on parole pursuant to this section and his parole is thereafter cancelled he shall not be further released on parole otherwise than in accordance with the provisions of subsection (1) of this section. .
