

DISTRESSED PERSONS RELIEF TRUST.

AN ACT to amend the Distressed Persons Relief
Trust Act, 1973.

[Assented to 6th November, 1974.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Distressed Persons Relief Trust Act Amendment Act, 1974.* Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Distressed Persons Relief Trust Act, 1973 is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Distressed Persons Relief Trust Act, 1973-1974.
