AN ACT to amend the Liquor Act, 1970-1973.

[Assented to 18th November, 1974.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Liquor Act Amendment Act, 1974.*

(2) In this Act the Liquor Act, 1970-1973 is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Liquor Act, 1970-1974.

2. Item 1 of the Fourth Schedule to the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by substituting for the passage “7½%” under the column headed “Percentage under section 159 (2)” opposite the words “Tavern Licence and a Store Licence”, the passage “8%”; and
 - (b) by substituting for the passage “5½%” under the column headed “Percentage under section 159 (2)” opposite the passage “All other Licences (except a Vigneron’s Licence)”, the passage “7%”.
