

WEIGHTS AND MEASURES.

No. 4 of 1974.

AN ACT to amend the *Weights and Measures Act, 1915-1973.*

[Assented to 19th September, 1974.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Weights and Measures Act Amendment Act, 1974.*

(2) In this Act the *Weights and Measures Act, 1915-1973* is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the *Weights and Measures Act, 1915-1974.*

5. Section 29 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "twenty miles" in line seven of subsection (2) and substituting the words "thirty kilometres".
