AN ACT to amend section thirty of the Mental Health Act, 1962-1968.

[Assented to 2nd October, 1972.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Mental Health Act Amendment Act, 1972*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Mental Health Act, 1962-1968 is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted as approved for reprint, 8th July, 1966 and amended by Act No. 16 of 1968.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Mental Health Act, 1962-1972.

2. Subsection (1) of section 30 of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "law" in line three of paragraph (c), the words "or of attempting to take his own life".
