**AN ACT to amend the Bills of Sale Act, 1899-1966.**

*[Assented to 6th December, 1971.]*

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Bills of Sale Act Amendment Act, 1971.* Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Bills of Sale Act, 1899-1966, is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted as approved for reprint 7th April, 1971.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Bills of Sale Act, 1899-1971.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

3. The Thirteenth Schedule to the principal Act is amended by substituting for the passage—

Where the amount or value of the consideration or the sum secured

does not exceed \$100	.....	.....	1.00
exceeds \$100	.....	.....	2.00

the following passage—

Where the amount or value of the consideration or the sum secured

does not exceed \$100	.....	.....	2.50
exceeds \$100	.....	.....	5.00 .
