### AN ACT to amend the Evidence Act, 1906-1967.

[Assented to 10th December, 1971.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Evidence Act Amendment Act, 1971.* Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Evidence Act, 1906-1967, is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted. Approved for reprint 16th August, 1966, as amended by Acts Nos. 20 of 1966, 23 of 1967, and 69 of 1967.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Evidence Act, 1906-1971.
