

FISHERIES.

No. 47 of 1971.

AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Act, 1905-1969.

[Assented to 10th December, 1971.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Fisheries Act Amendment Act, 1971*.

(2) In this Act the Fisheries Act, 1905-1969, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Fisheries Act, 1905-1971.

2. Subsection (3) of section 35L of the principal Act is repealed and re-enacted as follows—

(3) The moneys in the Fund may be used and applied by the Minister in such manner and in such proportion as the Minister thinks fit for all or any of the following purposes—

- (a) scientific, technological or economic research in relation to fisheries;
- (b) investigation, exploration and development of fisheries;
- (c) the provision of extension services related to fisheries; and
- (d) assisting—
 - (i) the fishing industry; and
 - (ii) any body, whether incorporate or not, whose objects include assistance to, or promotion of, the fishing industry,

and not otherwise. .
