

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

No. 66 of 1971.

AN ACT to amend the Local Government Act,  
1960-1970.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1971.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Local Government Act Amendment Act, 1971*.

(2) In this Act the Local Government Act, 1960-1970, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Local Government Act, 1960-1971.

Amendment  
to s. 245A.

2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section two hundred and forty five A of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the word “structures” in line four the words “or devices”; and
- (b) by adding after the word “land” in line 9 the words—

but no structure or device shall be deemed to be a compliance with this requirement unless the structure or device is of a sort approved and described by the Minister. .
