

## EDUCATION (No. 2).

AN ACT to amend the Education Act, 1928-1970.

[Assented to 30th November, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Education Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1970.*

(2) In this Act the Education Act, 1928-1970, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Education Act, 1928-1970.

2. Section 1A of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "TEACHERS" in line six, the passage "AND APPOINTMENT TO OFFICES ON STAFF OF TEACHERS' COLLEGES".

3. Section 9A of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by deleting the passage commencing with the word "purchase" in line two of paragraph (a) and ending with the word "to" in line seven thereof;
- (b) by deleting the passage commencing with the word "purchase" and ending with the word "that" in line fifteen of paragraph (a);
- (c) by deleting the word "and" immediately following paragraph (c); and
- (d) by adding after the word "matriculation" in line five of paragraph (d) the following passages—

- (e) subsidising efficient schools to and including the thirty-first day of December nineteen hundred and seventy, for the purpose of enabling those schools to purchase any equipment, instruments, appliances and things, of a kind or class in respect of which, when purchased for a Government school, the Minister pays portion of the purchase price; and
- (f) the provision, on and from the first day of January nineteen hundred and seventy-one, of annual grants as determined by the Minister, to efficient schools for the purpose of enabling those schools to purchase any equipment, instruments, appliances or other things .

Heading amended.

4. The heading immediately preceding section 10 of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "TEACHERS" the passage "AND APPOINTMENT TO OFFICES ON STAFF OF TEACHERS' COLLEGES".

Amendment to s. 10. (Training of teachers.)

5. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word "Training" in line two the word "Teachers".

S. 10A added.

6. The principal Act is amended by adding after section 10 a section as follows—

Offices on staff of Teachers' Colleges.

10A. (1) Where a vacancy occurs in an office on the staff of any teachers' college to which section ten of this Act refers, or a new office is created on the staff thereof, applications for appointment to any such office may be advertised throughout such places in the Commonwealth or in the Commonwealth and outside the Commonwealth and at such times, as the Director General may direct.

(2) A person may apply for, and be appointed in accordance with this Act to, any such office whether or not he is on the teaching staff of the Education Department at the time of his appointment to the office. .

Amendment to s. 13. (Compulsory attendance.)

7. Paragraph (b) of subsection (4) of section 13 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word "three" in line two the word "two".

Amendment to s. 37AE. (Jurisdiction of Tribunal.)

8. Paragraph (d) of subsection (3) of section 37AE of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "Department" in line two, the passage "not being an office to which section ten A of this Act applies,".
