No. 2 of 1969.

AN ACT to amend the Administration Act, 1903-1966.

[Assented to 21st April, 1969.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Administration Act Amendment Act, 1969.* Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Administration Act, 1903-1966, is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted approved for reprint 11th September, 1967.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Administration Act, 1903-1969.

2. Section one hundred and thirty-four of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by adding after the word, "Act" being the last word in paragraph (f) of subsection (1), the following passage—

“ ;

(g) the Services Canteens Trust Fund established under the Services Trust Funds Act, 1947 as amended from time to time, of the Parliament of the Commonwealth” ; and

(b) by substituting for the figures “1956” in line four of subsection (2), the figures “1969”.
