

JUDGES' SALARIES AND PENSIONS.

No. 26 of 1969.

AN ACT to amend the Judges' Salaries and Pensions Act, 1950-1966.

[Assented to 16th May, 1969.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Judges' Salaries and Pensions Act Amendment Act, 1969.*

(2) In this Act the Judges' Salaries and Pensions Act, 1950-1966, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Judges' Salaries and Pensions Act, 1950-1969.

2. Section five of the principal Act is amended by repealing and re-enacting subsection (1) as follows—

Amendment
to s. 5.
(Judges'
salaries.)

(1) As from and including the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, the Judges are entitled to the following salaries—

- (a) the Chief Justice of Western Australia to an annual salary at the rate of eighteen thousand dollars;
- (b) the Judge who is senior of the Judges other than the Chief Justice of Western Australia, whose office shall be known as that of Senior Puisne Judge, to an annual salary at the rate of sixteen thousand five hundred dollars;
- (c) each other Judge to an annual salary at the rate of sixteen thousand dollars,
