**AN ACT to amend the Mining Act, 1904-1968.**

*[Assented to 7th May, 1969.]*

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Mining Act Amendment Act, 1969.* Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Mining Act, 1904-1968, is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted in Vol. 20 of the Reprinted Acts and amended by Act No. 53 of 1968.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Mining Act, 1904-1969.
