

ROAD CLOSURE.

No. 94 of 1969.

AN ACT to provide for the closure of portion of Mount Street and Rights of way and for incidental and other purposes.

[Assented to 17th November, 1969.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Road Closure Act, 1969*.

Closure of portion of Mount Street, City of Perth.

2. (1) All that portion of the public road, known as Mount Street in the City of Perth, being—

the land abutting Perth Lots L29, L30, L31, and L32, containing an area of two roods

thirteen and three tenths perches, and delineated and bordered blue on Lands and Surveys Original Plan No. 10270,

may be closed by proclamation and all rights of way over it shall thereupon cease.

(2) When the portion of the public road referred to in subsection (1) of this section is closed pursuant to that subsection, the land comprised in that portion shall be revested in Her Majesty as of her former estate and shall be removed from the operation of the Transfer of Land Act, 1893 with the intention that it be disposed of in such manner as the Governor may approve.
