Australia and its Dependencies,

vested by a certain act of the Imperial Par-  
liament of Great Britain and Ireland,  
passed in the fifth and sixth years of Her  
Majesty's reign, intituled "An Act for re-  
gulating the sale of waste lands belonging  
to the Crown in the Australian Colonies,"  
I do hereby notify and proclaim that the
