Proclamation.

By His Excellency JOHN HUTT Esq., Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same.

In pursuance of the authority in me vested by a certain act of the Imperial Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the fifth and sixth years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled "An Act for regulating the sale of waste lands belonging to the Crown in the Australian Colonies," I do hereby notify and proclaim that the following Town allotment of land will be offered for sale by public auction at the Office of the Collector of Revenue, in Perth, on Wednesday, the first day of November next, at the upset price affixed thereto, on the terms and conditions set forth in certain land regulations dated 14th June, 1843—

Perth allotment E No. 7. Upset price, £30.

Given under my hand and seal at Perth this fifth day of October, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three.

The forage allowance consists of 14 lbs. of hay and 7 lbs. of oats a day; and the contractor will be required to deliver a month's supply at a time.
