quire, Governor and Commander-
in-Chief of the Territory of Wes-
tern Australia and its Depen-
dencies, and Vice-Admiral of the

In pursuance of the authority in me
vested by a certain Act of the Imperial
Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland,
and passed in the fourth and fifth years of
Her Majesty's reign, intituled "An Act
"for regulating the Sale of Waste Lands
"belonging to the Crown in the Australian

"Colonies," I do hereby notify and pro-
