PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency ANDREW CLARKE, Esq., K.H. Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Territory of Western Australia and its Dependencies and Vice-Admiral of the same.

In pursuance of the authority in me vested, by a certain act of the Imperial Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, and passed in the fourth and fifth year of her Majesty's reign, intituled, "an act for regulating the sale of waste lands belonging to the Crown in the Australian colonies," I do hereby notify and proclaim, that the following portion of Land, in the district of Perthshire, will be offered for sale by Public Auction, by the Collector of Revenue at Perth, on Wednesday, the 13th day of January, 1847, at the upset price affixed thereto, on the terms and conditions set forth in certain land regulations dated the 14th June, 1843.

Canning Location No. 23, comprising 100 acres more or less, in form of a square, each side of which measures 40 chains parallel or perpendicular to the S.E. boundary of Canning location No. 31, the W. corner of the section to be at a post piled up with stones on said S.E. boundary at about 157½ chains N.E. from its S.W. end.

Upset price 20s. per acre.
