IRWIN, ESQUIRE, Knight Companion
of the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic
Order, Governor and Commander-in-
Chief of the Territory of Western
Australia and its Dependencies, and
Vice Admiral of the same,

In pursuance of the authority in me ves
ted, by a certain act of the Imperial Par
liament of Great Britain and Ireland, and
passed in the fifth and sixth years of Her
Majesty's reign, intituled 'an act for regu
lating the sale of waste lands belonging to
the Crown in the Australian colonies,' I do
hereby notify and proclaim, that the fol
