WITH reference to the 10th clause of the Depasturing Regulations at present in force, giving to fee-simple proprietors a preferable right to rent the adjacent unoccupied Lands of the Crown, His Excellency the Governor directs it to be notified, for general information, that such priority of right will not be recognised after the 31st of December next.
