By His Excellency ARTHUR EDWARD KEN-
NEDY, ESQUIRE, Governor and Commander
in-Chief in and over the Territory of
Western Australia and its Dependencies
and Vice-Admiral of the same.

WHEREAS by the 49th section of
an Ordinance passed in the 17th
year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen
Victoria, intituled, "An Ordinance to
provide for the general Regulation of the
Customs in Western Australia," it is
enacted that it shall be lawful for the
Governor with the advise of his Executive
Council by his Warrant from time to time
to appoint ports in the said colony which
shall be Warehousing Ports: Be it there-
fore known unto all men that I the Go-
vernor aforesaid, have with the advice of
my Executive Council appointed and do
hereby appoint Port Vasse to be a Ware-
housing Port and that Wines, Spirits, and
Tobacco may be bonded for payment of
duty thereat.
