Road from Sinclair's Causeway to Twine's House.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that it is the intention of the Government to alter the line of Road laid out by Mr. Forrest between Sinclair's Causeway, on the Avon River, and Twine's House.

The Road, as altered, is to start from a spot on the cleared road, about 150 yards from the foot of "Rocky Hill" on the South side of a brook, nearer the East corner of Avon Location 72; from thence to run in an easterly direction towards Twine's House, through Location U I, keeping the South side of said brook, and joining the cleared road where that road crosses the West boundary of Location 32.

Full particulars of this line of road will be published in a future notice, after the road is surveyed and laid out; and the public are in the mean time cautioned against fencing across or otherwise obstructing the track above ascribed.
