Proclamation

FRED. A. WELD,

By His Excellency FREDERICK ALOYSIUS WELD, Esquire,
Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Terri-
tory of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c.,
&c., &c.

WHEREAS it is enacted, by the tenth Section of an Ordinance passed in the twenty-fifth Year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, No. 3, intituled "An Ordinance to organize and establish a Volunteer Military Force in Western Australia," That it shall be lawful for The Governor at any time to disband any Corps raised under authority of such Ordinance, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, and that from the date of such Proclamation, all engagements to serve as Volunteers shall cease and determine; Now therefore I, FREDERICK ALOYSIUS WELD, the Governor aforesaid, do proclaim that the Perth Company of Western Australian Volunteers be, and it is hereby disbanded.
