By His Honor EDWARD DOUGLASS HARVEST, Lieutenant-Colonel in Her Majesty's Army and Senior Military Officer in Command of Her Majesty's Land Forces in Western Australia, Administering the Government of Western Australia and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by the First Section of an Act passed in the 34th year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, No. 8, and intituled "An Act to enable the Governor "to extend the 'Fremantle Carriage Ordinance, 1868,' to other Towns," power is given to the Governor of the said Colony to extend the provisions of such Ordinance to such other Towns as he may deem expedient; NOW THEREFORE I, Edward Douglass Harvest, Administering the Government of the said Colony, do hereby notify and proclaim that I have extended the provisions of the said Ordinance to the Town of York.

Given under my hand and seal at Perth, this seventeenth day of March, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, and in the thirty-seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign.
