WHEREAS, by divers Acts of the Imperial Legislation, it is made lawful for the Governor of the Colony of Western Australia for the time being to fix such place within any part of the said Colony, and such time for holding every Session of the Legislative Council of the said Colony, as he may think fit; NOW THEREFORE I, FREDERICK ALOYSIUS WELD, Esquire, being Governor as aforesaid, in exercise of the powers so in me vested, do hereby announce and proclaim that a SESSION OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA shall commence and be holden for the despatch of business on WEDNESDAY, THE FIRST DAY OF JULY, 1874, at two o'clock in the afternoon, in the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, in the CITY OF PERTH, within the said Colony; and the Members of the Legislative Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

TWENTY-FIRST NOTICE.

S.O.L.—AVON (*Biddle's*).

Bounded on the *Southward* and *Eastward* by lines extending West-south-west 65 chains, and North-north-west 23 chains from the North-east corner of Avon Location P 4; the opposite boundaries being parallel and equal, and bearings magnetic. Content—100 acres.

S.O.L.—AVON (*Bowke's*).

Bounded on the *Southward* by the Northern boundary of Tillage Lease 7093, measuring 58 chains 33 links. On the *East-north-east* by a North-north-west line of 19 chains 14 links. On the *North-north-west* by a West-south-west line of 45 chains 33 links, then South-south-east 9 chains 14 links, and West-south-west 13 chains; and on the *West-south-west* by 10 chains of the North-east boundary of Special Occupation License 227. All persons having in their possession any of the effects of the Bankrupt must deliver them to the Trustee, and all debts due to the Bankrupt must be paid to the Trustee.
