### SOUTH AUSTRALIA—ST. VINCENT GULF. ALTERATION IN PORT ADELAIDE LIGHT.

With reference to Notices to Mariners Nos. 122 and 7, dated respectively 18th November 1873 and 15th January 1875, on an alteration to be made in Port Adelaide light:—

Further information has been received, that the alteration has been made and that the light is now a revolving white light showing a flash every thirty seconds, and in clear weather should be seen from a distance of 17 miles.

The illuminating apparatus is dioptric or by lenses, of the first order.
